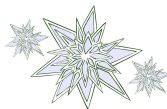

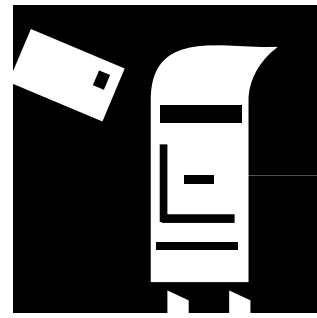

## Did You Know?

Noisy toys can hurt your child's hearing...  
Children often don't use toys the way they were  
designed to be used. Many kids hold toys  
much closer to their ears then is safe.

Self-defense: Buy only toys whose sound  
levels are not disturbing when used in  
the way your child is likely to use them.

Caution: *In a toy store, loud sounds  
of toys may seem muffled.*

Eating peanut butter plain, directly from the jar,  
can cause choking. The peanut butter can  
be sucked into airways, block them, and spread into  
the lungs. If that happens, not even the  
Heimlich maneuver can dislodge it.

Safer: *Spread peanut butter on  
bread, toast or crackers.*

Feeding hot dogs to young kids can be dangerous.  
Always cut the hot dogs into tiny pieces. If a child  
should choke on a piece of hot dog,

Call 911 and use the Heimlich maneuver.

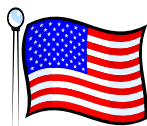
